Special Note for Sets 4 & 5: Network breaks shown in sets 4 & 5 below are optional and will not be taken if there is not a set. Local breaks noted in sets 4 & 5 will be taken in each set. If there is no set 4 and/or set 5, then those two local breaks will be taken back to back in the postgame as two back to back one minute breaks. This allows you to program all local breaks into your automation system and automate the volleyball broadcast no matter how many sets are actually played

All local breaks include an extra two seconds (no matter how long the break is) for local affiliates to insert a quick station liner within their local break.
